

Minister of Worship and Students

Cornerstone Baptist Church of Warrenton, VA (www.cornerstoneva.org) is seeking a Minister of Worship and Students to help grow our church to the next level. The overall purpose of the position is to help the church move forward with its mission of seeing people become fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ and a vision of seeing those shaped lives build bridges to shape other lives.

Specific responsibilities for this full time position include

Worship Duties (approximately 20 hours per week)

- coordinating and leading worship during our Sunday Morning Service
- recruiting for and developing the band.
- working towards a rotating schedule for band members on Sundays
- meeting with the Senior Pastor for worship planning
- working with and coordinating the AV team

Student Ministry Duties (Approximately 20 hours per week)

- Lead and organize effective age appropriate student ministry implementing fellowship, biblical teaching, discipleship, and evangelism through current small group model.
- Create and lead ministry and mission opportunities.
- Coordinate and lead volunteer youth staff.
- Provide counseling and spiritual direction to youth on an individual basis.
- Facilitate communication with students, keeping them informed of activities.
- Communicate with parents on ministry strategies and plans in a way that encourages partnership and involvement.
- Work to develop and provide oversight of the youth ministry budget.
- Seek to integrate student ministry into all phases of church life to create a culture that is intentionally intergenerational, striving to unite with and complement other church ministries, as well as participating in ministries to the community.
- Other duties as required.

Qualifications and Position Requirements:

- One who exhibits a personal and growing relationship with God, a teachable spirit, a heart to serve and is energetic.

- One who possesses a minimum of a bachelor's degree with a church ministry focus or related field preferred, experience in youth ministry and leading worship, basic administrative skills, and a personal spiritual life congruent with biblical mandates for leaders (1 Timothy 3:1-7).
- One who loves young people, and has a passion for seeing people come to Christ and to grow in Him, both personally and at the ministry level.
- A capable teacher, with a strong biblical and theological background, who is in agreement with Cornerstone's Statement of Faith, Mission and Vision.
- A self-motivated leader, capable of casting and imparting vision for ministry, possessing relational skills with students, parents, and staff.
- Good communicator and well organized in planning, implementing and following up on ministry responsibilities.
- Willing to be a member of the Cornerstone fellowship and to work towards the Cornerstone Relational Values.
- Equivalent combination of educational or work experience and personal abilities and giftedness which provides the required skills, knowledge and abilities may be considered for the above requirements.
